Peschiera - Borghetto - Castellaro Lagusella - Desenzano - Peschiera 60 km / 450 hm (may vary depending on route changes) Category RED

## Opportunities for rest and photo stops:

Valeggio/Borghetto with the old stone bridge, reminiscent of Venice in miniature.

- Castellaro Lagusella with a lake and a church on a hill, a secluded place with many restaurants, and a magnificent location.
- Madonna della Scoperta, a lonely church on a hill in the southern Lake Garda area, with a rustic restaurant that may not always be open.
- Solferino, where the Red Cross was founded, with a castle and restaurant, a small town in the southern Lake Garda area where time seems to stand still.
- Desenzano is the largest town on Lake Garda, with a castle and promenade with restaurants
- Peschiera, with its old town and fortress, restaurants, and lively atmosphere at the southern end of Lake Garda.

A magnificent ride with ups and downs, but mostly flat riding to get acclimated and make first contact with Lake Garda. The tour runs south of Lake Garda and along the only outflow of the lake, the Mincio River, first to Valleggio/Borghetto. It continues through the magnificent landscape of vineyards and olive groves. Depending on the season, the area shines in many colors. Whether it is spring, summer, or autumn - it is always a vacation for the eyes.
