

Peschiera - Bardolino - Torri del Benaco - Albisano - San Zeno di Montagna - Lumini - Caprino - Peschiera

75 km / 1100 hm (may vary depending on route changes)

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Opportunities for rest and photo stops:

- Bardolino is a lively tourist magnet with a harbor and restaurants.
- Torri del Benaco is a beautiful place by the lake with a relaxed atmosphere. Have an espresso in the morning before the climb.
- Albisano is a village above Torri with a fantastic view of the lake.
- San Zeno di Montagna is situated above Albisano and has a breathtaking location. The altitude also makes the temperature more bearable in the summer.
- Lumini is a small village in the mountains, like a mountain village in the Alps.

Another highlight day is on the program. An early start is recommended to get to Torre del Benaco as quickly as possible along the Gardesana road. A coffee awaits in a small cafe by the road before the climb. Then it's a comfortable ascent with a gentle incline on a narrow road, first to Albisano. The village is about 300 meters above the lake and from there, through the forest and serpentine roads, to San Zeno di Montagna.

The high altitude provides pleasant temperatures and after passing through, we turn right towards Prada. Along a magnificent road, we reach the junction to Prada, but we turn right and ride along a narrow, beautiful road down to Lumini. The village is usually sleepy, and taking photos is a must. The descent to Caprino is very long, and the narrow road with rough asphalt demands concentration. From Caprino, we ride through several villages with more or less traffic in the hinterland to return to Peschiera.
